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SouthEast Alaska Pilots' requires that all applicants pass a physical agility test prior to taking the SEAPA exam at MITAGS-West. This is to ensure that every applicant meets the physical requirements demanded to safely board and disembark vessels underway at sea.

If an applicant is temporarily injured, but is expected to make a full recovery, they may elect to take the physical agility test at a later date. The applicant must submit a signed copy of this form with a letter from their doctor stating the injury, anticipated date of full recovery, and the physical address with contact phone number of the doctor's clinic.

By signing this form the applicant acknowledges:

- 1. He/she/they will not be eligible for a training position with SEAPA until the applicant has passed the required agility test.
- 2. The applicant may maintain an "ineligible status" on the SEAPA trainee waiting list until that list has been exhausted of all other successful applicants. At that time, SEAPA will run another exam and the applicant will be required to re-apply and retake the entrance exams.
